YOUR DECLARATION SHOULD CLEARLY INDICATE IF YOU OR YOUR PASSENGERS ARE BRINGING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IN TO CANADA.

- 1) Firearms, other weapons or offensive sprays
- 2) Goods which exceed personal exemptions
- 3) Endangered species or goods derived from them
- 4) Business materials, professional or commercial goods
- 5) Animals, birds, meats, dairy products.

Note:

- * A facsimile transmission must be sent a minimum of 1 hr. and a maximum of 72 hrs prior to take off
- * A Facsimile transmission must be followed up by a telephone call to confirm acceptance
- * On arrival the pilot or agent must contact the TRC to confirm arrival, except CANPASS members.
